Led by a 24 year old paralyzed young woman, Cody Unser, nine veterans, living in wheelchairs themselves, are finally released to go where everyone else goes with no worry of high curbs or large steps getting in the way. This is a story of the discovery of freedom through weightless movement and of self renewal; based on an experience they never believed they could have on a reef 60 feet below the surface of the sea. In the process this amazing medical pilot study, chronicled by Johns Hopkins doctors, may change the lives of anyone with paralysis.

“Sea of Change” will give hope and a potential course of action to the 5.6 million Americans living with some form of paralysis.
